Notice of Hearing on Proposed Assessments

Notice is hereby given that the Olivia City Council will meet at 5:30 p.m. or as soon as possible thereafter on September 21, 2026, at City Hall, 1009 W. Lincoln Ave., Olivia, Minnesota, to consider final assessments for unpaid fire call fees. Adoption by the Council of the proposed assessments may occur at the hearing.

Individual letters have been mailed directly to the property owners stating the amounts to be specially assessed against the property. Such assessments are proposed to be payable in one (1) payment, beginning January, 2027.

Persons may at any time prior to the certification of the assessments to the County Auditor, pay the entire assessment on such property to the City of Olivia by November 25, 2026.

The proposed assessments are on file for public inspection at City Hall, 1009 W. Lincoln Ave., Olivia, Minnesota. Written or oral objections will be considered at the meeting. No appeal may be taken as to the amount of the assessments unless a written objection signed by the affected property owner is filed with the City Clerk prior to the assessment hearing or presented to the presiding officer at the hearing.

The owners may appeal the assessments to district court pursuant to Minn. Stat. §429.081 by serving notice of the appeal upon the mayor or clerk of the city within 30 days after the adoption of the assessments and filing such notice with the district court within 10 days after service upon the Mayor or Clerk.
